

Installing RLF Files in Carveco

Thank you for purchasing this RLF pack from CNC Carver's Workshop!

Follow these steps to import and use your RLF files in Carveco:

- 1. Unzip the download file:
 - Extract all contents to a folder on your computer.
 - You'll see a folder containing multiple .RLF files and this PDF.
- 2. Move the folder into your Carveco Relief Library:
 - Navigate to your Documents folder.
 - Open: Documents > Carveco > Relief.
 - Inside, you will see other folders (e.g., Animals, Signs, etc.).
 - Copy the entire folder you just unzipped into this 'Relief' folder.
 - Make note of the folder name, as this will appear in Carveco.

3. Open Carveco:

- Go to the Relief Clipart Library.
- You should now see your new folder listed in the library.
- Open it to view and use all of your new RLF files.

4. Add to a project:

- Double-click or drag and drop reliefs into your current model.
- Resize, position, and combine them as needed.
- These files have been optimised for stacking and working together.

5. Set your toolpaths:

- Use a roughing pass with a 3mm end mill.
- Use a finishing pass with a 1mm or 1.5mm ball nose bit.
- Adjust depth and step-over to retain detail.
- 6. Preview and export your toolpaths:
 - Simulate your toolpaths to confirm everything looks correct.
 - Export your G-code for your CNC machine.
